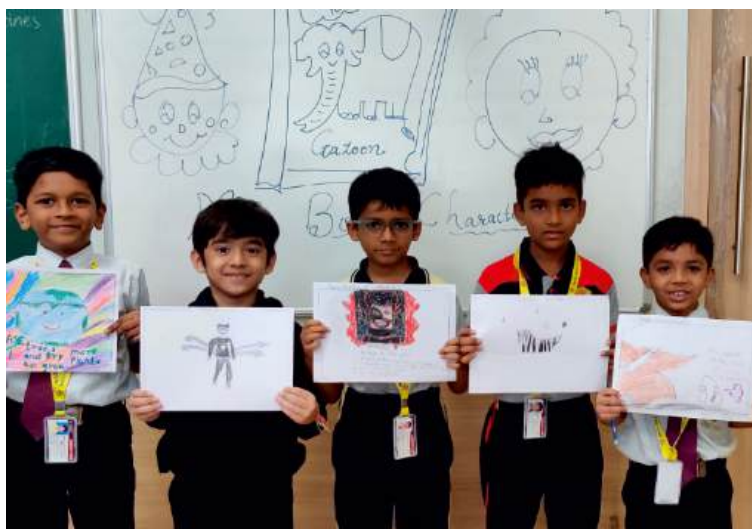

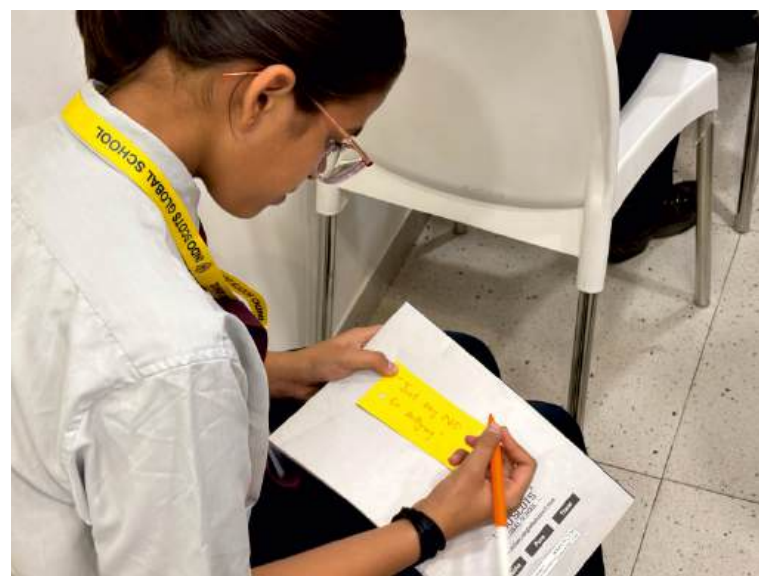
WORKSHOP ON "SAFE AND UNSAFE TOUCH" AT ISPS

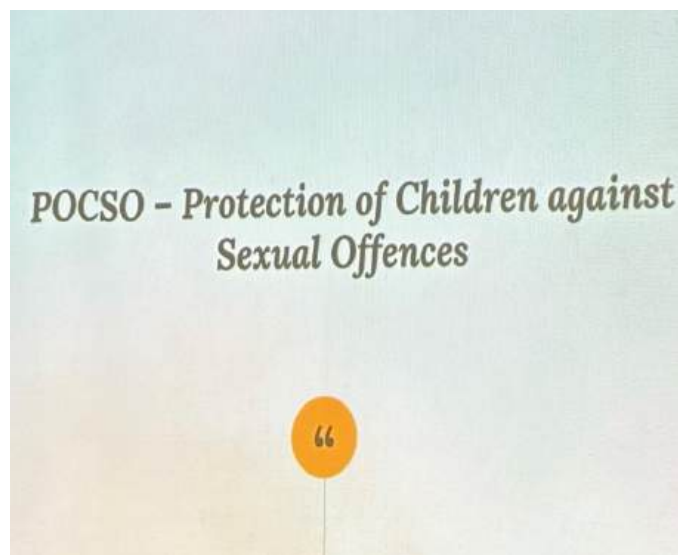


WORKSHOP ON - ANTI-BULLYING

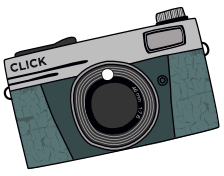

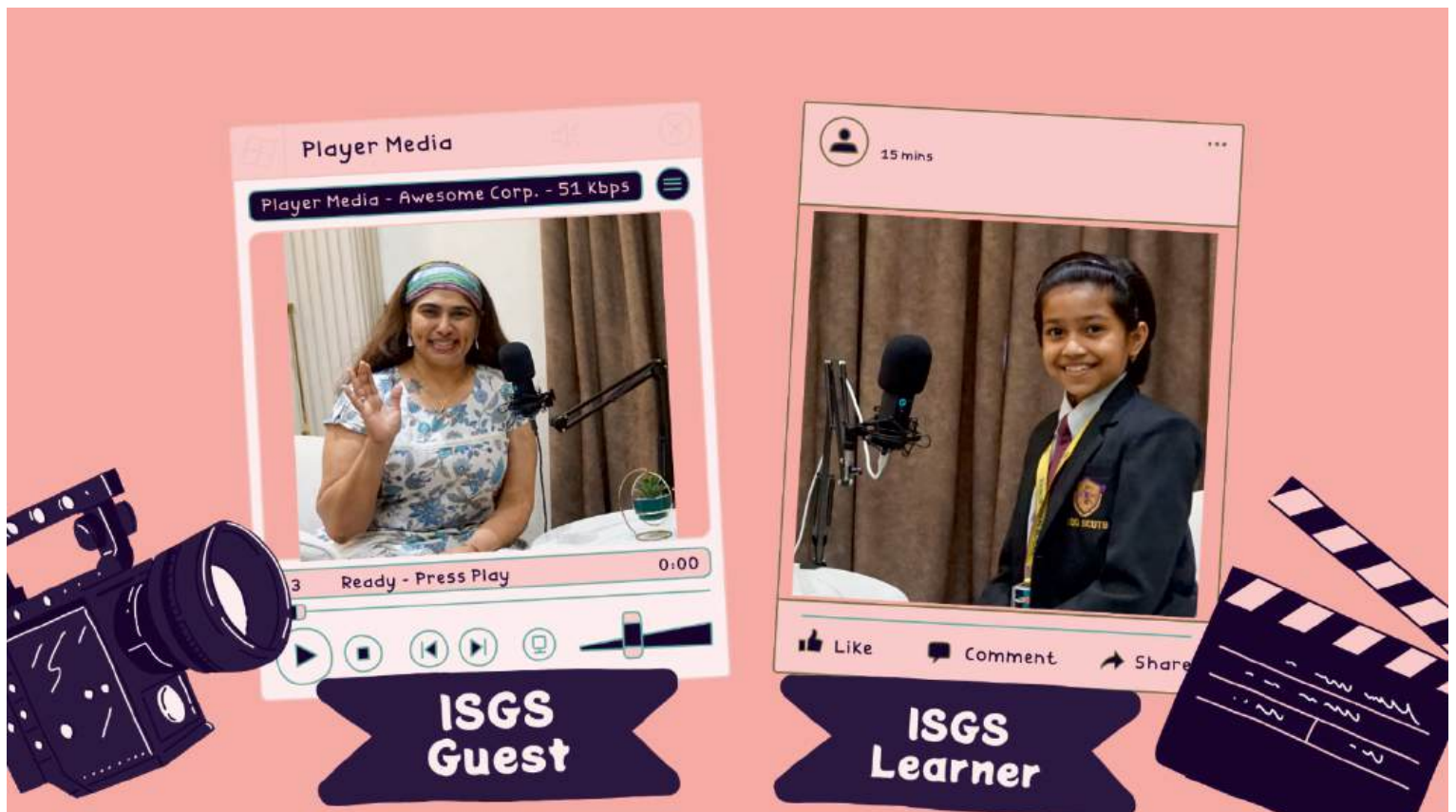
FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK

We invite the entire ISGS community to tune in, support our learners, and be a part of this enriching journey.

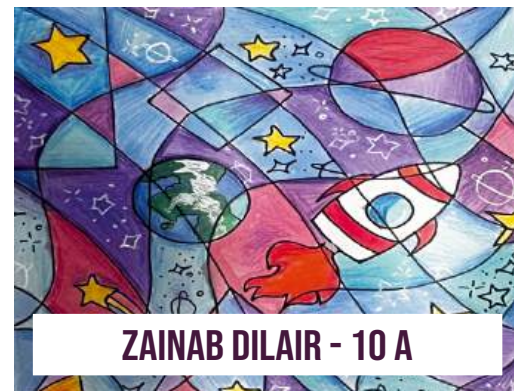
