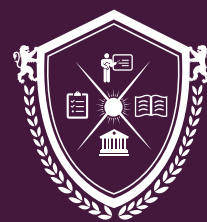

These simple yet meaningful activities nurtured eco-awareness and reminded us that even the smallest hands can help shape a greener tomorrow.



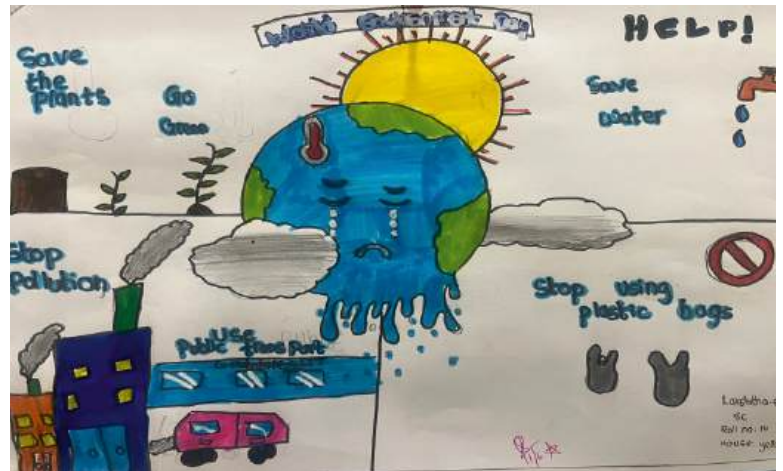
"ONE EARTH, ONE FUTURE"

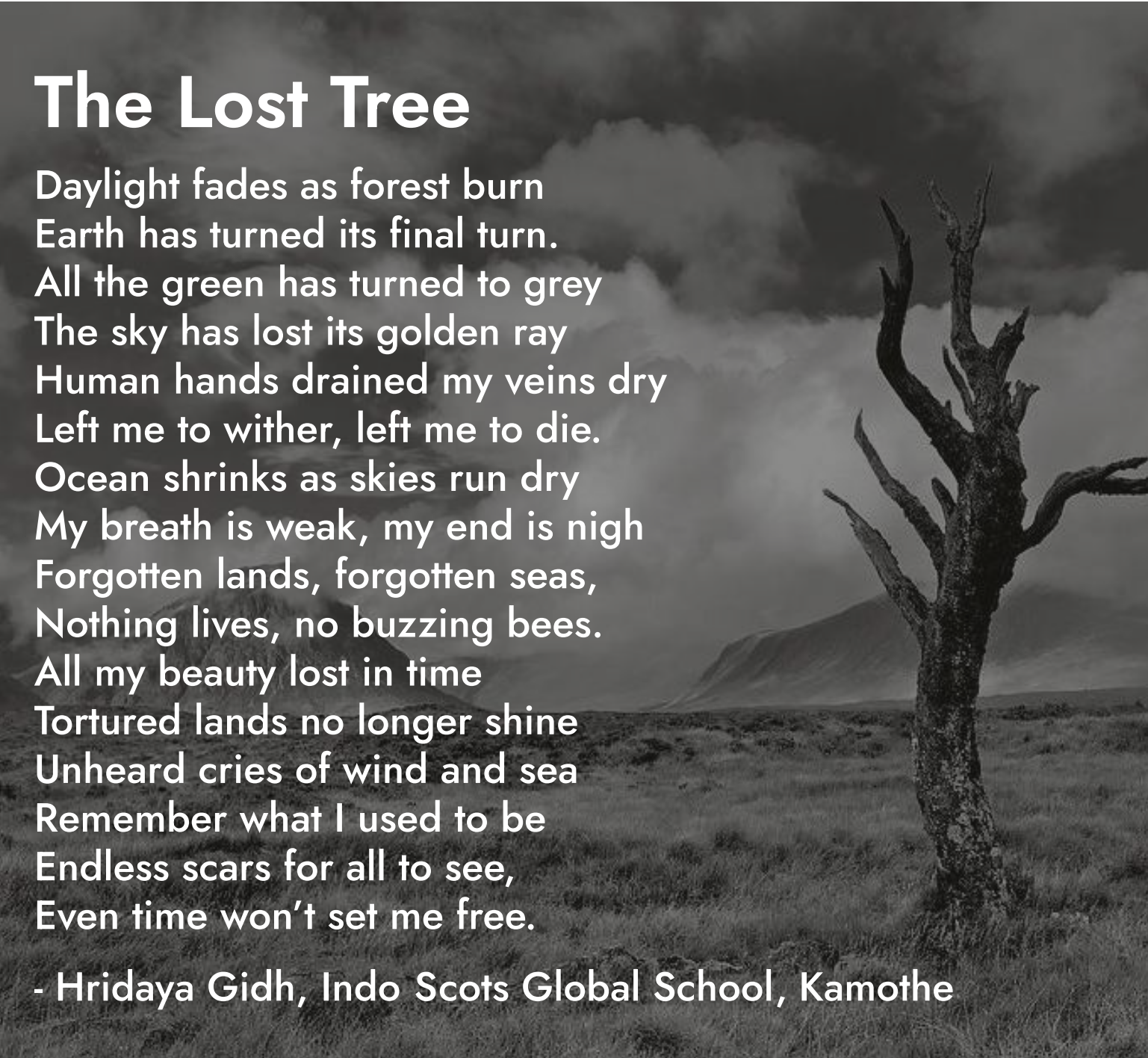

The Lost Tree

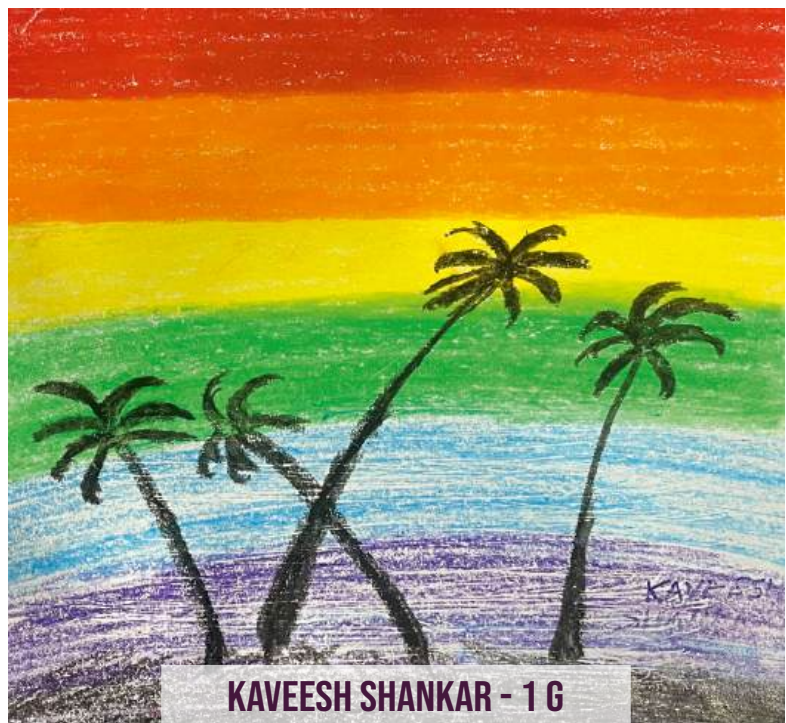


Daylight fades as forest burn

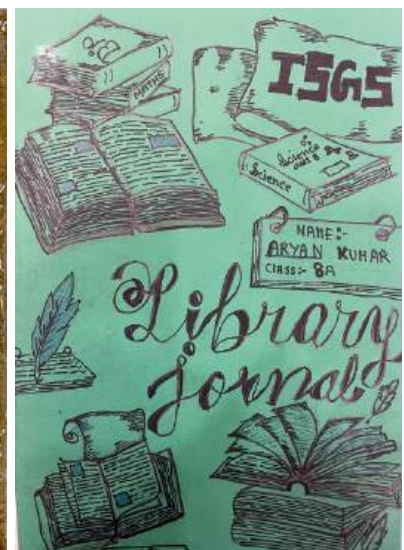
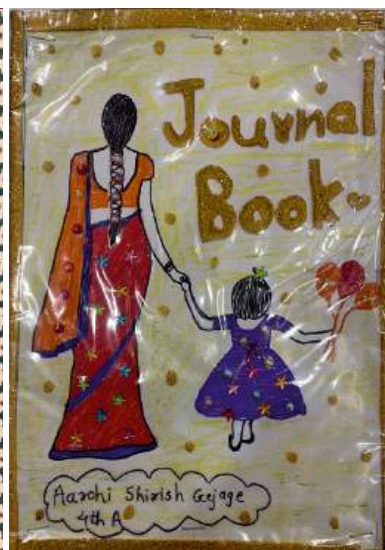
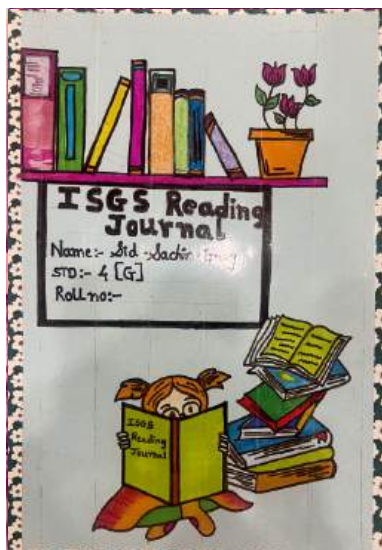
