ISGS LITFEST 2025: A CARNIVAL OF CREATIVITY

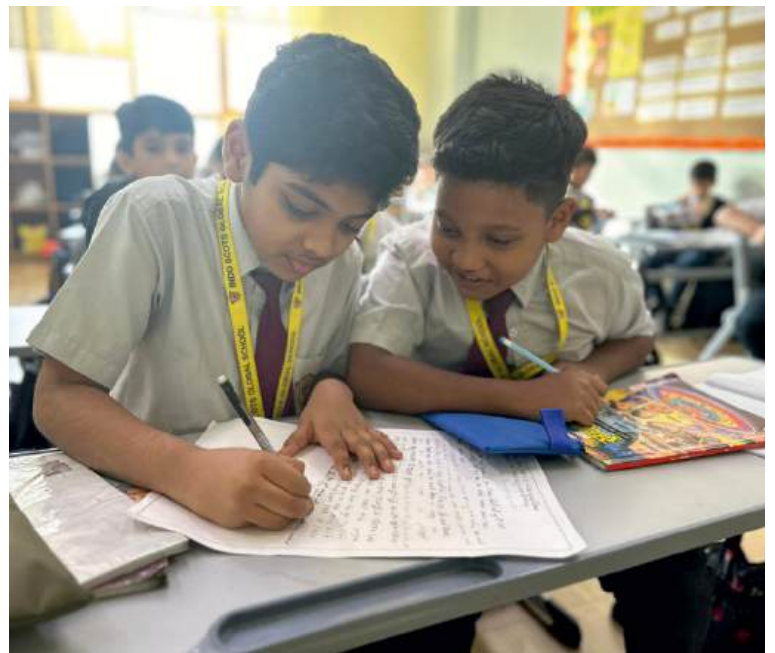

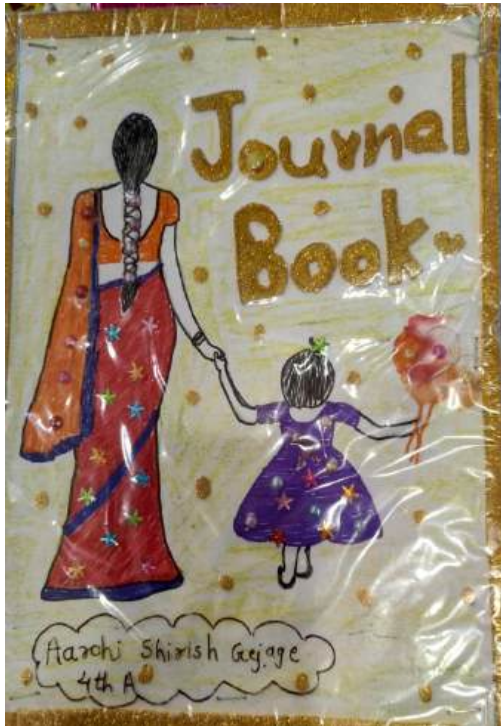


CANVAS OF DREAMS
